Monitoring the New Brunswick Financial and Consumer Services Commission, Insurance Division, as it proposes a restricted licensing regime for incidental insurance¹ sales (*insurance sold in conjunction with the sale of other products or services*) and its impact on Mortgage Brokers. ¹*The New Brunswick Insurance Act currently prohibits anyone from acting as an insurance agent or broker without a license.*

Working with CMBA National on launching a Canada wide ad campaign (reaching over 1 million people) with video clips that members can share and use as marketing tools.

Participating in an NSAR webinar open to Realtors® and CMBA members discussing updates on the mortgage market, tips for clients, market outlooks and much more.
